

Pursuant to New York State Real Estate Property Law §442-H Standardized Operating Procedures for Tenants & Purchasers of Residential Real Estate

Further, prospective tenants or home buyers are not required to provide personal identification, to sign an exclusive buyer representation agreement or to provide proof of mortgage pre-approval prior to receiving services from Terrace Sotheby's International Realty and its licensed brokers and salespeople.
